BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows:

Amendment of 1999 Constitution

- Amendment of Section 6 by altering paragraph (c) of subsection 6 referred to as the "Principal Act") is hereby amended as set out hereunder 1. The Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, 1999 (With Alterations) (in this Bill
- or otherwise, by the respective organs of government as follows: as enshrined in section two of the 1999 Constitution have been or are being adhered to to inquire into whether the fundamental objectives and directive principles of state policy 2. Section 6 (6) (c) of the Principal Act is amended by granting judicial powers to the courts

with the Fundamental Objectives and Directive Principles of State Policy set out in Chapter shall extend to any issue or question as to whether any act of omission by any authority II of this Constitution" or person or as to whether any law or any judicial decision is in conformity or otherwise 'The judicial powers vested in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this section (c)
