

1 21. Buying or selling a person for a purpose.

2 Any person who-

3 (a) Buys, sells, hires, lets or otherwise obtains custody or disposes of
4 any person under the age of eighteen years with intent that such person be
5 employed or used for immoral purposes or knowing it to be likely that such a
6 person will be employed or used for any such purposes, commits an offence
7 and is liable on conviction to imprisonment for fourteen years without the
8 option of a fine;

9 (b) Entices, takes, or harbors a pregnant woman out of the custody of
10 her husband, parents, or guardian for the purpose of racketeering with such
11 pregnancy, or willingly, sells or attempt to sell the unborn baby, commits an
12 offence and is liable on conviction to imprisonment for a term 10 years;

13 (c) Engage in any of the acts enumerated in sub paragraphs (a), (b),
14 and (c) for the purpose of collecting pecuniary returns from the activities shall
15 be deemed to have aided and abated therefore commits an offence and shall be
16 punished as if same offence was committed personally.

17 **5.** Section 64 of the Principal Legislation is hereby amended by

19 "immoral purpose means an act that is conflicting with general tradition,
20 particularly sexually related activities"

This Bill seeks to amend the Trafficking in Persons (Prohibition) Law Enforcement and Administration Act No. 28 of 2005 to prohibit Racketeering with Pregnancy, Baby Production Factory, Human Organ Harvesting.
