Question One

(a) Write a brief report (not more than 2 pages) on any policy activity you have participated in recently.

Question Two

(a) Suppose the average length of time used for voting has been 30 minutes, now electronic Smart Card Reader (SCR) is being tried. If with a sample of 20 (SCR) the average voting time becomes 25 minutes with a standard deviation of S=8 minutes, test the hypothesis that the population mean is now less than 30 minutes, using a level of significance of:

(i) 0.05; and

(ii) 0.005. (**5 marks**)

(b) The Speaker of the Nigerian House of Assembly has claimed that 70% of the bills sent to the Executive are signed into law. In the past few months, 10 out of 20 of such bills were signed by the Executive. Is the Speaker's claim correct? Test the claim at 5% level of significance.

Question Five

(a) Past election results in Edo State indicate that 60% of Benin City voters are needed to win the governorship election. A pre-election survey in Benin-City indicates that candidate A is only favoured by 660 out of 1,000 in the sample. Is it likely that candidate A will win? Test this result at 1% level of significance.

(b) An Independent Observer wished to find out the level of dedication to work of Senate Committees members using absenteeism as a measure of low level of dedication. A Sample of a particular committee-working day resulted to the following table. What can be deduced from the sample?

Question Six

Write short notes on the following:

(a) Report-Writing; and Pre-Writing Activities.

(b) Research reports expressed as:

(i) C = 400 + 0.70Y; for which standard errors of estimates are (95.5)and (0.21) respectively and sample size is 20. (5marks)

(ii) A Linear Probability Model (LPM) H = -0.9457 + 0.1021Y for which sample size is 40; where C = Consumption; Y = Income and H represents ownership of a house.
