Question One

Question Four

- (a) Using not less than five points distinguish between Harvard and APA referencing styles. (7.5 marks)
- (b) Estimate the sample size to be used for a research involving a community with a population of 2830 persons:
 - (i) Using Yamen formula (for which allowable error is e = 0.05). (5 marks)
 - (ii) If standard deviation of the population is known to be $\sigma=25$ and standard deviation of sample mean is $\sigma_x=4$. (5 marks)

- (a) Write an essay on the importance of sampling in social research. (7.5 marks)
- (b) A given population is made up of traders, teachers, tailors and touts in the following percentages 25, 18, 20 and 37. Determine the number of each group that may be included in a sample of 78 persons:
 - (i) If proportional stratified sampling plan is employed. (5 marks)
 - (ii) If disproportionate stratified sampling is used (5 marks)
